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Smart TV Caveats

Cautions you should consider

Smart TVs with online access to the Internet are becoming more and more common – a trend that’s not likely to reverse anytime soon, if ever. If you’re in the market for one of these, there are a few caveats you may want to think about.



First, it should be said that if your priority is a high-quality television and you can get one at a good price, it doesn’t matter if it happens to have additional Internet connectivity features.

Those features are extra bonuses, and you don’t need to use them

if you don’t want to. They shouldn’t add much (if anything) to the cost, and it’s soon enough going to be hard to find a TV that doesn’t have them.

However, at least one popular satellite dish provider offers a feature for TVs that have a DVR (digital video recorder) and their Internet connectivity switched on – they will automatically download a continuous stream of popular movies, up to 10 per day, from which you can choose what to watch from your DVR with no delay or buffering.

That may sound great, but be aware that it’s a massive bandwidth hog. OCS technicians have already found several user accounts with significant increases in bandwidth usage following the purchase of a new TV and DVR system. These users had not normally been high bandwidth users, and they were completely unaware that this feature was switched on or what it was actually doing.

Secondly, according to a recent report, Smart TVs from major manufacturers like Samsung, Philips and LG are easy targets for eavesdropping. Researchers were able to obtain login data and even snoop on browser sessions, leading to the suggestion that Smart TV users should never use banking websites, or other sites requiring sensitive personal information, on their TV sets.
