2012 CONTENT AREAS

Libraries of all types and sizes are transforming in a dynamic and increasingly global information environment with changing needs, expectations, demographics and technologies. Join us to explore and influence the many dimensions of this transformation.

Transforming: Community Relationships

Shift your focus from the library mission to the library's role in helping to meet the community's mission. Look at the skills required to identify and bring stakeholders together, to collaborate. Focus on outcomes – community impact.

Transforming: Customer & User Expectations

User expectations are changing. Libraries must increasingly focus on assessment criteria relevant to users. 




