This program is strictly for those who are currently in Kindergarten and going into the First grade in August 2015. The skill building series schedule will include sessions in Math, Reading, and Writing for 4 weeks. The program session will be 2 hours per day, Monday – Friday, 10am-noon, and will take place at the **Margaret J. Slattery Children's Library at 256 East Orange Avenue** inside the Heritage Center.

The Porterville City Library will provide the educational materials, a daily snack, and instructors. The Library staff are not trained educators but we have ran a sustainable program with the Santa Fe Elementary School for several school years that provides the same skill building service to at-risk students. Parents are welcome to volunteer and participate in all skill building activities.

**This is a <u>FREE</u> service to the Porterville community and it is entirely geared for those students who *really need that* extra help with early learning skills.
